Change of Director and Alternate Director

The MTR Corporation announces that that Mrs Ingrid Yeung, who will cease to hold the post of the Commissioner for Transport with effect from 15 July 2017, will cease to be a Non-executive Director ('NED') of the Corporation and a member of its Audit Committee and the Risk Committee, all with effect from the same date.

The Commissioner for Transport is a NED of the Corporation appointed by the Chief Executive pursuant to the Mass Transit Railway Ordinance (Chapter 556 of the Laws of Hong Kong). The Corporation will make a further announcement after the new Commissioner for Transport has been appointed by the Government.
