21 December 2017**Production and Testing Completed  
for the First of the 93 New Urban Lines Trains**

A ceremony was held today (21 December 2017) in Qingdao to mark the completion of testing of the first 8-car train of the 93 new trains procured by the MTR Corporation to replace existing trains operating on the Kwun Tong, Tsuen Wan, Island and Tseung Kwan O lines.

To maintain high quality railway service for customers and as part of its long-term asset renewal strategy, after a rigorous tendering process, the Corporation awarded a HK\$6 billion contract in July 2015 to CRRC Qingdao Sifang Co., Ltd. (CRRC Sifang) to produce 93 new trains to replace those currently running on the four urban lines.

These trains are equipped with advanced operating systems and a number of new features in the passenger compartments including improved lighting systems, new dynamic route maps and double branched handrails. They are also compatible with the new signalling system which is being installed on Hong Kong's urban rail lines.

"We are looking forward to the delivery of the new trains to further enhance the travelling experience of our customers. I would also like to express my gratitude to our engineering staff who have been stationed at the factory since the commencement of production to work with CRRC Sifang in ensuring that the quality of our new trains is of a world class standard," said Mr Adi Lau, Operations Director of MTR Corporation, at the ceremony to mark the production milestone.

The first new train is expected to be delivered to Hong Kong in early 2018 while the remaining trains will arrive in batches between 2018 and 2023. Upon arrival, the trains will undergo stringent testing and commissioning procedures before they put into service.
