

MTR Appoints New Director

The MTR Corporation is pleased to announce that Mr Lam Sai-hung, who will be appointed to the post of Permanent Secretary for Development (Works) ("PS for D") with effect from 13 October 2018, will by virtue of his appointment become a Non-executive Director ("NED") of the Corporation as well as a member of the Capital Works Committee and the Risk Committee of the Corporation on the same date.

PS for D is an NED of the Corporation appointed by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region pursuant to the Mass Transit Railway Ordinance (Chapter 556 of the Laws of Hong Kong).
