Re-appointment of Chairman of MTR Corporation

The MTR Corporation welcomes the announcement by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region today (19 November 2018) that the Financial Secretary Incorporated has re-appointed Professor Frederick Ma Si-hang as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Corporation for six months, with effect from 1 January 2019 to 30 June 2019. Professor Ma has been serving as the Chairman of the Corporation since 1 January 2016.

"I must thank the members of the Corporation's Board of Directors for their relentless support during the past three years, as well as all MTR staff for their efforts in successfully delivering three new railway lines, including the Kwun Tong Line Extension, the South Island Line as well as the High Speed Rail service. Together, we also achieved the vision of establishing the MTR Academy which nurtures aspiring professionals in the railway industry in Hong Kong and in the Belt and Road Region," said Professor Ma.

"The Board places a lot of importance on safety, customer centricity and communication, and in my remaining term, I would like to see enhanced efforts by the Corporation to build on its good foundations to improve even further to meet rising customer expectations," Professor Ma added.

"I have advised the Government some time ago that I would stay on for a limited period to undertake the important task of conducting a global search exercise to identify a new CEO for the Corporation," said Professor Ma.
