#### MTR Enhances Train Services for Christmas and New Year Holiday Season

The festive season is right around the corner! To make passengers' journeys more convenient during the upcoming holidays, MTR will be providing an extra 803 train trips over Christmas and the New Year holidays.

Passengers who wish to stay out late celebrating on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve can enjoy overnight train services on all local MTR lines (except the Airport Express, Disneyland Resort Line and journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations). Additional train trips will be provided starting from the afternoon of 24 and 31 December to serve passengers' needs. (See details in Annex)

We anticipate that there will be a higher demand for public transport during the holidays, therefore we will enhance our services for passengers to travel with ease to fully enjoy the festivities," said Mr Adi Lau, Operations Director of MTR Corporation.

#### **Disneyland Resort Line**

#### **Light Rail**

To provide greater convenience to West Rail Line passengers and residents of the Northwest New Territories, Light Rail routes 505, 507, 610, 614P, 615P, 706 and 751 will run throughout the night on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve at 15 to 18-minute intervals.

#### MTR Bus

MTR bus routes 506 and K51 feeding the West Rail Line will extend service to 2am on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve with buses running at 10 to 15-minute intervals.

#### iii) Airport Express

For the convenience of those travelling overseas, Airport Express service will be enhanced as follows:

	Service Details
22-24 December 2018	The first train departs from Hong Kong Station at 5:00am (50 minutes earlier than normal service) and at 5:26am from AsiaWorld-Expo Station.
26 December 2018 & 1 January 2019	The last train departs from AsiaWorld-Expo Station (via Airport Station) at 1:25am (40 minutes later than normal service)

#### **General Reminders**

Passengers taking the MTR during holidays are recommended to use their Octopus cards. Single journey ticket users are encouraged to purchase two tickets at their starting station, keeping one ticket for their return journey.

To cope with the anticipated increase in passenger flow, special crowd control arrangements will be in place at busy stations such as Jordan, Tsim Sha Tsui, East Tsim Sha Tsui, Admiralty, Wan Chai, Causeway Bay and Tin Hau. Passengers are reminded to follow the advice from station staff and the police.
