MTR Steps up Local and Cross-boundary Train Service for Lunar New Year
East Rail Line Lo Wu Station Extends Service Hours to 2:30am
on the Eve and the Second Day of Lunar New Year
Passengers Advised to Pay Attention to Connecting Transport Arrangements

To facilitate the travel of the public and tourists during Lunar New Year, MTR Corporation will enhance train services on seven railway lines starting from this Saturday (3 February 2024) and provide overnight service for local railway lines on Lunar New Year's Eve (9 February 2024).

To support the Government's arrangement to extend the operating hours of the Lo Wu Control Point on Lunar New Year's Eve and the Second Day of the Lunar New Year (9 and 11 February 2024) until 2:00 am on the following day, cross-boundary train services on the East Rail Line for Lo Wu Station will also be extended on these two nights. However, train service for Lok Ma Chau Station will remain as usual, with the last north-bound train to Lok Ma Chau Station departing from Admiralty Station at 9:29 pm.

Passengers should take note of the service hours of the connecting transportation during the extended service hours at the Lo Wu Control Point on those two nights, and make early arrangements for their north-bound or south-bound connecting journeys. In particular, as the other local railway lines will maintain regular service hours on the second day of the Lunar New Year, passengers who travel on East Rail Line on that night are urged to plan their connecting journeys with other modes of transport in advance.

Service Enhancement and Overnight Service of Local Railway Lines on Lunar New Year's Eve

Starting from this Saturday until the ninth day of Lunar New Year (3 to 18 February), MTR will increase train frequencies during various periods on weekends and public holidays, covering all Heavy Rail lines (except Airport Express). On Lunar New Year's Eve, all local railway lines (except Airport Express and Disneyland Resort Line), and seven Light Rail routes will operate overnight. Three MTR buses routes will extend service hours. Around 1,850 additional train trips will be provided throughout the Lunar New Year period to facilitate passenger travels. <u>East Rail Line to Extend Cross-boundary Train Service for Lo Wu Station on the Eve and the Second Day of Lunar New Year</u>

Following the Government's announcement to extend the operating hours of Lo Wu Control Point until 2:00 am on the day following the Eve and the Second Day of the Lunar New Year, train service for Lo Wu Station on the East Rail Line will be extended on both nights to facilitate passengers' travel. The Lok Ma Chau Spur Line Control Point will close as usual at 10:30 pm on these two nights, and there will be no extended service for the East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station.

During these two nights, the last north-bound train on the East Rail Line to Lo Wu Station will depart from Admiralty Station at 12:56 am and arrive at Lo Wu Station at approximately 1:46 am, about 14 minutes before the control point closes. Passengers are advised to pay attention to the closing time of the control point and manage their time accordingly.

The last south-bound train on the East Rail Line will depart at 2:30 am from Lo Wu Station (approximately half an hour after the control point closes) and will arrive at Admiralty Station at about 3:20 am. Passengers should pay attention that other local railway lines will not provide extended service on the Second Day of the Lunar New Year and will maintain their regular last train schedules. Passengers taking East Rail Line trains on the day may not be able to interchange to other local railway lines. Therefore, they should make advance preparations for other modes of transport to connect to their destination. (Please refer to Annex 2 for details of East Rail Line service extension.)

"Every Lunar New Year, MTR enhances train services to facilitate passengers in their outings for festive shopping and gathering with family and friends. This year, we have made special arrangements to extend the cross-boundary train services on the East Rail Line for Lo Wu Station to support the extension of operating hours at the checkpoint. This further facilitates the travel of both the public and visitors between Hong Kong and Mainland to enjoy the festive season," said Ms Jeny Yeung, Managing Director – Hong Kong Transport Services of MTR Corporation.

Passengers can check the last train schedules for various railway lines using the MTR Mobile app or the MTR website, plan their journeys in advance and allow sufficient time for their trips. The Corporation will enhance information dissemination, station signage and public announcements for the extension of cross-boundary train service for Lo Wu Station. Additional staff will also be deployed on Lunar New Year's Eve and the Second Day of the Lunar New Year to assist passengers.

During the festive season, as there may be higher than usual passenger volumes at stations and on trains, the Corporation reminds passengers to prioritise safety and maintain courtesy especially when using escalators, to ensure a smoother journey. Before boarding the First-class compartments on the East Rail Line, passengers using Octopus cards are required to complete First-class validation at the First-class Processor on platforms, or purchase First-class tickets in advance (passengers using QR code are required to choose First Class Service before gate entry on mobile apps), to enjoy a more comfortable travel environment. Fare adjustment is not available in First-class compartments.

As the Year of the Dragon approaches, the Corporation wishes all passengers and travellers a safe and prosperous year ahead!
