#### **MTR Enhances Train Services during Easter Holidays Around 300 Extra Train Trips to be Added**

MTR Corporation will enhance services on the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, South Island Line and Disneyland Resort Line starting from this Friday during certain service hours over the Easter holidays (29 March to 1 April 2024). Around 300 additional train trips will be operated to cater to the public's travelling needs.

To support the government's grand outdoor art project "Art@Harbour 2024" along both sides of Victoria Harbour, train frequency of the Island Line and Tsuen Wan Line will be increased during the evening and at night to provide convenient access to the Central Harbourfront for citizens and tourists to enjoy illuminated art installations and participate in various art and cultural activities during the holidays. For the South Island Line, there are three time periods throughout the day when the service will be enhanced (7:00 am to 9:00 am, 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm, and 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm). For the Disneyland Resort Line, service intervals will be enhanced from 9:00 am to 9:30 am and from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm, and the train frequency will be enhanced to about every 5 minutes to provide convenience for visitors to the theme park. (Please refer to the annex for details.)

To facilitate the public's tomb-sweeping activities, the service of MTR Bus route K52A, which operates between Tuen Mun Station and Tsang Tsui Columbarium, has been enhanced starting from 16 March and for most of the time periods on Saturdays and Sundays during the Easter holidays, Ching Ming Festival and the following two weekends. Frequency will be stepped up from about every 60 minutes to about every 15 to 30 minutes.

With more travellers expected during Easter holidays, passengers are advised to allocate sufficient time for their journeys. There will be enhanced announcements and signage at Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line and Hong Kong West Kowloon Station of the High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section), and extra staff will also be deployed to assist passengers. The Corporation will closely monitor the operations of different railway lines, and continue to suitably adjust train services.
