- 1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 2 or Line 9. Get off at Jingtian Station and walk about 4 minutes from Exit B.
- 2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and then transfer to Line 2 at Grand Theater Station.
- 3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot. Take Line 4 and then transfer to Line 2 at Civic Center Station.
- 4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot and take Line 2.
