

【Shenzhen】 Guiwan Park

A Monet-inspired flower sea in bauhinia garden!

	Guiwan Park is Qianhai's first water corridor park, built along the Guiwan River with water features and leisure spaces.
	Three pedestrian bridges span the river, offering stunning views of the lush greenery, azure lake, and the city skyline. The sunset provides a particularly breathtaking backdrop for photographs, beautifully blending modernity with nature.
	The park's highlight is the Bauhinia Garden, renowned for its "Monet-style" flower sea reminiscent of French Impressionist paintings. It features a colourful array of flowers, such as pansies, Chinese roses, and classic roses. No matter where you stand, you'll be greeted by a palette-like view of blooming colours, enhanced by seasonal themed displays.
	In autumn, visitors can enjoy picnics on the grass fields, cycle along the riverbank, or watch the sunset from the bridges, enjoying a relaxing afternoon.

Address: Intersection of Qianhai 1st Road and Tinghai Avenue, Nanshan District, Shenzhen

Transportation:

1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 5 or Line 9. Get off at Qianwan Station and walk about 12 minutes from Exit B.
2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and transfer to Line 5 at Qianhaiwan Station.
3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 10. Transfer to Line 11 at Gangxia North Station and then transfer to Line 5 at Qianhaiwan Station.

4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot. Take Line 11 and transfer to Line 5 at Qianhaiwan Station.
