





【Shenzhen】 Guiwan Park
A Monet-inspired flower sea in bauhinia garden!

	<p>Guiwan Park is Qianhai's first water corridor park, built along the Guiwan River with water features and leisure spaces.</p>
	<p>Three pedestrian bridges span the river, offering stunning views of the lush greenery, azure lake, and the city skyline. The sunset provides a particularly breathtaking backdrop for photographs, beautifully blending modernity with nature.</p>
	<p>The park's highlight is the Bauhinia Garden, renowned for its "Monet-style" flower sea reminiscent of French Impressionist paintings. It features a colourful array of flowers, such as pansies, Chinese roses, and classic roses. No matter where you stand, you'll be greeted by a palette-like view of blooming colours, enhanced by seasonal themed displays.</p>
	<p>In autumn, visitors can enjoy picnics on the grass fields, cycle along the riverbank, or watch the sunset from the bridges, enjoying a relaxing afternoon.</p>

 Address: Intersection of Qianhai 1st Road and Tinghai Avenue, Nanshan District, Shenzhen

- Transportation:
1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 5 or Line 9. Get off at Qianwan Station and walk about 12 minutes from Exit B.
 2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and transfer to Line 5 at Qianhaiwan Station.
 3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 10. Transfer to Line 11 at Gangxia North Station and then transfer to Line 5 at Qianhaiwan Station.

4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot. Take Line 11 and transfer to Line 5 at Qianhaiwan Station.
