
[Shenzhen] Nanshan's Safety Education Center Five interactive zones for an immersive learning journey!



Nanshan Safety Education Experience Center is a place where education meets fun. Through interactive games, adults and children alike can learn safety knowledge while enjoying the experiences, thereby enhancing their resilience in emergencies.



The Center features 8 major safety-themed zones and over 40 interactive experiences. In the Home Safety Experience Zone, children and adults can take part in a quiz on the safe use of electricity while learning proper handling of electrical appliances. In the Self-Rescue Simulation Interactive Experience, participants can learn self-rescue skills through simulated scenarios of being trapped in an elevator. They can also learn abdominal thrust first aid and AED equipment operation, so that they can lend a helping hand in critical situations.



In the Fire Safety Zone, participants are instructed on how to escape from a fire beyond simply making emergency calls. In various real-life scenarios, adults can learn knot-tying, while kids can practise sliding to safety.



In the Traffic Safety Zone, children can learn how to navigate roads safely through simulated experiences such as school bus accidents and road crossings, while the Drink Driving VR Experience lets participants feel the dangers of drink driving.



There are also rare scenarios, such as the Construction and Industrial Safety Experience Zone, which highlights key safety principles in different industries. Another highlight is the 4D Disaster Experience Center, where typhoons and earthquakes are simulated to children to experience natural disasters through their senses of sight, sound and touch. This immersive approach helps to strengthen their disaster awareness.

Friendly reminder: group visits of 10 people or more must be booked in advance.

Getting there:

- 1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 12. Get off at Zhongshan Park Station and walk about 10 minutes from Exit C.
- 2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and then transfer to Line 12 at Taoyuan Station.
- 3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 4. Transfer to Line 1 at Convention and Exhibition Center Station and then transfer to Line 12 at Taoyuan Station.
- 4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot. Take Line 11 and then transfer to Line 12 at Nanshan Station.
