[Shenzhen] Shenzhen Art Museum (New Venue) A destination for art lovers where art meets technology!



Located in Longhua District, the Shenzhen Art Museum (New Venue) took four years to complete. Focusing on art and technology, it combines history and the future. With a simple and eye-catching architectural style, it is connected to the adjacent Shenzhen Library North. In just a few months since its opening, the new Museum has already become a popular destination for young art and literature enthusiasts.



Made up of diamond-shaped lattices, the Museum resembles a white square box. Meanwhile, the mist in the atrium water plaza presents different light and shadow effects, making it another unique scene.



With a gallery of nearly 6,000 square metres, the Museum boasts 18 art showrooms, an outdoor sculpture exhibition hall, an art library, a public education activity space, a cultural and creative shop and other multi-functional service spaces. Since its opening at the end of 2023, the Museum has been organising exhibitions of works of art from all over the world in different periods, ranging from Qi Baishi's masterpieces to French Impressionist oil paintings, from a photography exhibition on Shenzhen's development history to Japanese installation art, with themes spanning from the past to the present, and from the East to the West. With the space and number of galleries that can accommodate several exhibitions at once, the new Museum is a pilgrimage destination for art lovers. It is worth a visit even if you are not an art enthusiast.

- 2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and then transfer to Line 6 at Convention & Exhibition Center Station.
- 3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 4.
- 4. From High Speed Rail Shenzhenbei Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Shenzhen North Station on foot and take Line 6.
