	The restaurant takes a refined approach to dining, with meticulous attention to the presentation of every dish. A case in point is the appetiser selection, which is served in boxes styled as miniature natural landscapes, complete with moss and delicacies, offering a feast for both the eyes and the palate.
	Each dish is presented by a dedicated member of staff, with a brief introduction of its ingredients, textures and health benefits. For example, the signature “Mountain Delicacies of Fortune, Prosperity and Longevity”, made with morels, mushrooms and cordyceps, can boost immunity while promoting liver health and detoxification, making every meal an educational experience.
	The menu itself also deserves a special mention. Turn it over and you will realise that it is made from seed-embedded paper---simply plant it in soil, water it, and watch it sprout and flourish. This thoughtful touch symbolizes the continuation of love and beauty. This attention to detail is what makes the restaurant such a popular place.

1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 1. Get off at Qiaocheng East Station and walk about 20 minutes from Exit A.
2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Luohu Station on foot and take Line 1.
3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot. Take Line 4 and transfer to Line 1 at Convention & Exhibition Center Station.
4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot. Take Line 11 and transfer to Line 1 at Chegongmiao Station.
