

**New Entrance Opened at MTR Yuen Long Station**

A new entrance (Entrance/Exit K) was opened for public use at Yuen Long Station today (31 May 2017). Connected to a neighbouring residential development and shopping mall via a footbridge, the entrance enhances the convenience and comfort of access to the station for residents and shoppers. It also provides more direct access from the villages along Long Yat Road to the nearby shopping malls or destinations along Castle Peak Road.
