Changes of Director and Alternate Directors

The MTR Corporation announces today (27 July 2020) that Ms Mable Chan, who will move from the post of Commissioner for Transport to the post of Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) ('PS for T&H(T)') with effect from 1 August 2020, will cease to be a Non-executive Director ('NED') of the Corporation. Ms Chan will also cease to be a member of each of the Audit Committee and the Risk Committee of the Corporation with effect from the same date.

By assuming the new position as the PS for T&H(T), Ms Chan will become an Alternate Director to the office of the Secretary for Transport and Housing ('S for T&H') (Mr Frank Chan Fan), a NED of the Corporation, to replace Mr Joseph Lai Yee-tak who will cease to hold the post of PS for T&H(T) with effect from 1 August 2020. Mr Lai will also cease to be an Alternate Director of the Corporation with effect from the same date.

The Corporation also announces that Mr Andrew Lai Chi-wah has ceased to be an Alternate Director to Mr Christopher Hui Ching-yu (Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury), a NED of the Corporation, with effect from 25 July 2020.
