

MTR Launches New Bus Route K52A Connecting Tuen Mun and Tsang Tsui Columbarium

With the opening of Tsang Tsui Columbarium in Tuen Mun, the demand for public transport service along the area of Tsang Tsui, Lung Kwu Tan and Mong Hau Shek continues to build up. The MTR Corporation announced today (10 September 2021) the launch of a new MTR Bus Route, K52A (Tuen Mun Station – Tsang Tsui Columbarium) starting from 25 September 2021 (Saturday) to provide regular two-way feeder service for passengers during the opening hours of the columbarium.

Route K52A will run between 8 am and 6 pm from Monday to Sunday including public holidays. In addition, the current schedule of the existing bus route K52S departing from Lung Kwu Tan for Tuen Mun Station at 6:30 am and 6:50 am will remain unchanged.

“The MTR Corporation is committed to providing convenient and reliable transport services to passengers. The new bus route not only provides regular two-way bus services for passengers going to Tsang Tsui, but also strengthens the express service from the Lung Kwu Tan/Mong Hau Shek areas to Tuen Mun Station. We will closely monitor the demand for the service as well as passengers’ travel patterns on special days and make necessary arrangements to meet the actual needs of passengers,” said Mr Sammy Wong, Chief of Operating & Metro Segment of MTR Corporation.

The full fare of Route K52A is \$9.6, while the sectional fares between Tuen Mun Station and Lung Kwu Tan is \$4.8. Passengers using Octopus to interchange from Tuen Ma Line/Light Rail to Route K52A, or vice versa, can enjoy an interchange discount of up to \$4.8 for the journey covered by the Tuen Mun Station - Lung Kwu Tan section (Please refer to the annex for fare and journey details).

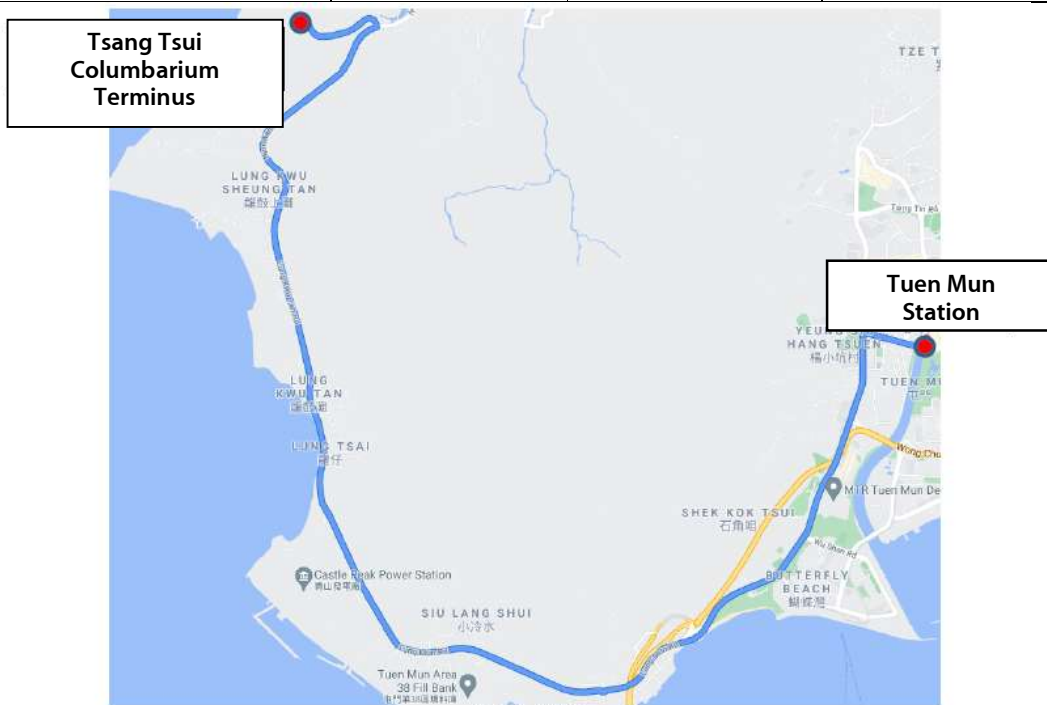

Note:

1. Passengers using Octopus need to tap **TWICE** for every journey to/from Tsang Tsui Columbarium. For those travelling to Tsang Tsui Columbarium, they should pay the fare for the first section (Tuen Mun Station to Lung Kwu Tan) when boarding the bus. After arriving at Tsang Tsui Terminus, they should pay the fare for the second section (to Tsang Tsui Columbarium) by tapping on the Octopus processor set up at the bus stop.

For passengers taking Tuen Mun Station-bound service at Tsang Tsui Columbarium to en-route stops, they should pay the full fare by first tapping on the Octopus processor at the bus stop and then tapping on the processor on the bus.

2. Elderly people aged 65 or above and eligible persons with disabilities who hold a valid Octopus Card can enjoy a concessionary fare of \$2 under the "Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities".
