Dr Rex Auyeung re-appointed Chairman of MTR Corporation

The MTR Corporation today (8 November 2021) welcomes the Government's announcement to reappoint Dr Rex Auyeung as the Non-executive Chairman of the Corporation for a period of two and a half years starting from 1 January 2022.

"It is an honour for me to be re-appointed. I am very proud to be part of the team that has been fully dedicated to keeping Hong Kong moving during the challenges of the pandemic. I look forward to continuing to bring many happy life's journeys to the people of Hong Kong in my new term as Chairman of MTR," said Dr Auyeung.

The cross-harbour extension of the East Rail Line will be open next year, and we are embarking on new railway projects which will extend the existing railway lines to cover a wider population in Tung Chung, Tuen Mun and the Northern New Territories. Dr Auyeung was first appointed a Non-executive Director of the MTR Corporation on 7 March 2019, with his term of two and a half years as Chairman commencing with effect from 1 July 2019.
