

MTR Enhances Service on Lunar New Year's Eve Normal Operating Hours to be Maintained in view of the Pandemic

MTR service will be enhanced in the afternoon and evening on Lunar New Year's Eve this year (31 January 2022) for the convenience of passengers heading home for celebrations as many passengers are expected to finish work earlier on that day. In addition, in view of the latest development of the COVID-19 pandemic and the social distancing measures imposed by the Government, MTR Corporation, after careful consideration, will maintain normal operating hours on Lunar New Year's Eve and overnight train service will not be provided.

The Corporation will increase train frequencies on the heavy rail lines (except Airport Express and Disneyland Resort Line) before and after the normal evening peak on Lunar New Year's Eve with a total of 270 additional trips. The Corporation will closely monitor train service before and during the Lunar New Year holidays and deploy additional trains to meet passenger demand when necessary. Holders of the MTR "Year of the Tiger" Commemorative Tickets can enjoy unlimited domestic journeys on the MTR network (except Airport Express, East Rail Line First Class, journeys to or from Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau and Racecourse stations) on the first day of the Lunar New Year (1 February 2022).
