

MTR Maintains Normal Operating Hours and Enhances Train Service on Mid-Autumn Festival

MTR Corporation announces the train service arrangements for Mid-Autumn Festival (10 September 2022). Train frequencies of some rail lines will be increased in the evening on that day to provide convenient travel to the public. In view of the latest development of the COVID-19 pandemic, overnight train service will not be provided.

Starting from 8pm this Saturday, train frequencies of the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line and Kwun Tong Line will be enhanced to every 3.8 to 4.2 minutes. The Corporation will closely monitor train operations on Mid-Autumn Festival and deploy additional trains and staff to meet passenger demand when necessary. The Corporation would also like to remind the public not to fly sky lanterns in areas near open sections of the railway network or bring any metallic balloons into MTR premises while celebrating the festival as these objects may affect railway operations. To ensure the safety of passengers and the railway, passengers with floating LED balloons will also be turned away from the MTR system as these objects could catch fire or explode.
