Arrangements by MTR Corporation on the Mourning for Former President of the People's Republic of China, Mr Jiang Zemin

The MTR Corporation deeply mourns Former President of the People's Republic of China, Mr Jiang Zemin.

All national flags, the regional flags and MTR flags displayed at MTR premises will continue to be flown at half staff tomorrow (6 December 2022) to show respect to the late Former President Mr Jiang.

The Corporation will display messages expressing condolences in electronic display panels at MTR station concourses during the memorial service tomorrow morning. Live broadcasts of the memorial service for Mr Jiang will be arranged at individual MTR malls, while other MTR malls will switch off all major televisions and LED screens during the mourning in silence in the memorial service. The Corporation will also suspend celebratory lighting and music at all MTR malls and MTR-managed offices for the whole day tomorrow.

The Corporation will arrange live broadcasts of the memorial service tomorrow at MTR office buildings for the staff to watch. During the mourning in silence in the memorial service, Dr Rex Auyeung, Chairman of MTR Corporation, and Dr Jacob Kam, CEO of MTR Corporation, will lead the management to observe three minutes' mourning in silence. MTR staff working in offices may also join the mourning.
