MTR Gets Ready to Fully Support Border Reopening

MTR Corporation welcomes the full border reopening between Hong Kong and the Mainland in a gradual and orderly manner, and gets ready to fully support the HKSAR Government for the border reopening arrangements.

“MTR has joined hands with the Hong Kong people in fighting the pandemic during the past three years. We look forward to resuming service at the Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations, as well as the West Kowloon Station. The team is working in full swing to prepare for the border reopening. We will maintain close contact with the relevant departments and fully support the Government to work out a resumption plan to reconnect Hong Kong and the Mainland in a gradual and orderly manner.” said Dr Jacob Kam, Chief Executive Officer of MTR Corporation.

During the suspension of cross-boundary train services, apart from maintaining the necessary operations, the team has been conducting various maintenance works and staff training to ensure all systems, equipment and shop facilities are in good conditions upon service resumption. Enhancement works have also been conducted to make passengers’ travel more convenient and comfortable.

As part of the Government’s pandemic prevention measures, Lo Wu and Lok Ma Cha stations of the East Rail Line have been closed since 4 February 2020, while the West Kowloon Station of the High Speed Railway has been closed and service suspended since 30 January 2020.
