Admiralty and Exhibition Centre Stations Win Five Architectural Design Awards

With the extension of the East Rail Line (EAL) in May, rail journeys across Victoria Harbour have never been easier. The cross-harbour link has also enhanced the connectivity of Hong Kong's railway network. In addition to winning the thumbs up of passengers, the newly extended Admiralty Station and brand-new Exhibition Centre Station on the EAL have recently been accorded five honours from three local and internationally renowned design and architectural award scheme, including The Hong Kong Design Awards 2022, The MUSE Design Awards 2022 and The Architectural MasterPrize 2022, in recognition of their innovative and outstanding architectural design, as well as their incorporation of artistic elements.

Awards conferred to the Admiralty Station extension:

- Gold Prize, Architecture – Public and Institutional by Hong Kong Design Awards 2022
- Silver winner, Architectural Design – Transportation by The MUSE Design Awards 2022
- Honorable Mention, Architectural Design/Transportation by The Architecture MasterPrize 2022

“The Admiralty Station extension and Exhibition Centre Station are among the major works of the East Rail Line cross-harbour extension. These awards are great recognition of the dedication and commitment of the team which has overcome many challenges to deliver an enhanced and efficient transport system for the public in Hong Kong,” said Mr Carl Devlin, Capital Works Director of MTR Corporation.

The Admiralty Station extension was built with a unique multi-level atrium. Over 50 metres deep, the new extension has become a signature feature of the station providing vertical circulation for the passengers with 34 new escalators. A stunning skylight drawing in natural light and the artwork “Mapping Our Way” displayed in the spacious atrium signify the convergence of the four railway lines housed in this mega station.

The three-storey underground Exhibition Centre Station, located in the heart of bustling Wan Chai North, energises the area by providing a more convenient transport connection across Victoria Harbour to different parts of the city. Inspired by its proximity to the harbour, the signature artwork “Water Memory”, one of the largest MTR station artworks, is composed of around 1,200 photographs capturing the nearby seascape at different moments.

The Muse Design Awards are selected by the leaders of a diverse range of marketing and advertising companies from around the world, which aim to set a new trend in design excellence by recognising creative and inspiring design. 


