#### **MTR to Provide Overnight Service on Lunar New Year's Eve and More Frequent Train Trips Before and During the Holidays Starting Today**

MTR Corporation announces today (13 January 2023) that overnight service will be provided on Lunar New Year's Eve (21 January 2023). The service of five railway lines will also be enhanced in the lead up to and during the Lunar New Year holidays.

For overnight service, all MTR railway lines (except the Airport Express, Disneyland Resort Line and journeys to or from Lok Ma Chau Station on the East Rail Line) will run trains overnight on 21 January, while service will be stepped up starting from 8pm on that day on the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line and Kwun Tong Line. Seven Light Rail routes (505, 507, 610, 614P, 615P, 706 and 751) will also provide overnight service on that day. MTR Bus routes 506, K51 and K54, meanwhile, will extend their service hours for Lunar New Year's Eve. (Please refer to Annex 1 for details)

Service on the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Kwun Tong Line, South Island Line and Tuen Ma Line will be enhanced during different periods today, this weekend, next Friday and during the first four days of the new year on the Lunar calendar (i.e. 13 – 15, 20, and 22 – 25 January). There will be a total of more than 1,800 additional train trips with train frequencies enhanced to between 2.3 and about 6 minutes. (Please refer to Annex 2 for details)

Moreover, the East Rail Line (between Admiralty and Sheung Shui) has been running additional train trips since 8 January with 3.2-to-6-minute intervals during most periods of the day to facilitate passenger demand after the re-opening of the Lok Ma Chau Spur Line Control Point. (Please refer to Annex 3 for details)

"Many people are out and about getting ready and having reunions before the Lunar New Year, as well as visiting their families and friends during the new year. Therefore, we are enhancing train service during the festival and providing overnight service on Lunar New Year's Eve to make the celebration all the more convenient. On behalf of MTR, I would like to wish our passengers a healthy and prosperous Year of the Rabbit," said Ms Jeny Yeung, Hong Kong Transport Services Director of MTR Corporation.

Holders of “Year of the Rabbit” commemorative tickets can enjoy unlimited domestic journeys in the MTR network, Light Rail, MTR Bus and MTR Shuttle Bus (except the Airport Express, High Speed Rail, East Rail Line First Class and journeys to or from Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau and Racecourse stations) on the first day of the Lunar New Year. The Corporation will continue to closely monitor train operations before and during Lunar New Year with train service adjusted based on actual demands when necessary.
