MTR Half Fares for Two Days This Weekend on “Thank You Days” 660 Train Trips Added and More Convenient Travel for Mother’s Day

The MTR Corporation will hold “Thank You Days” again this weekend (13 and 14 May 2023¹) to provide half-fare discount to thank passengers. MTR service will be enhanced during the “Thank You Days” with a total of 660 train trips added to cater to passengers’ travelling needs.

During “Thank You Days”, passengers can enjoy a 50% discount² for every trip with their Octopus on the MTR, Light Rail and MTR Bus running in Northwest New Territories, or when they travel with a QR code on the heavy rail network. The half fare applies to cross-boundary trips running to and from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line. Passengers can also enjoy the half fares together with any interchange, Fare Saver, and the 25% discount on connecting journeys with Monthly Pass.

“We would like to express our gratitude to passengers for their support with ‘Thank You Days’, which coincide with Mother’s Day this weekend. We hope the half-fare discount and more frequent train service will make travel all the more convenient when people are out celebrating with their families, during the warm and joyful days,” said Ms Jeny Yeung, Hong Kong Transport Services Director of the MTR Corporation.

Eight MTR lines including the Island Line, South Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Kwun Tong Line, Tuen Ma Line, East Rail Line, Tung Chung Line and Disneyland Resort Line will run more frequent train trips this Saturday and Sunday than on regular weekends, with a total of 660 train trips added. For the Light Rail, more coupled-set Light Rail vehicles will be used to increase carrying capacity. (Please refer to the annex for details of the train service enhancements.)

Extra manpower will be deployed at MTR stations to serve passengers during “Thank You Days”. The Corporation will closely monitor train operations and suitably adjust train service and manpower arrangements when necessary.

¹ Applies to the traffic hours of the MTR network, starting from the first train in the morning on Saturday until the last train on Sunday which departs after midnight (13-14 May 2023).

² East Rail Line First Class Premium, Airport Express and MTR Feeder Bus are excluded from the offer.
