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MTR Launches "Flexi-trip" Arrangement for Hong Kong - Futian Passengers Facilitates Convenient HK-SZ Travel with Easy Alteration of Same-day Trains

The High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section) ("HSR") service has been well-received by cross-boundary passengers since its resumption earlier this year, particularly for short-haul services to the Greater Bay Area. The HSR has become an essential bridge for deeper connection and exchanges between Hong Kong and the Mainland. As the operator of Hong Kong West Kowloon Station (WEK) and of specific routes, the MTR Corporation is dedicated to providing a comfortable and efficient journey for HSR passengers with a focus to upgrade facilities and enhance flexibility for passengers.

The Corporation announces today (8 August 2023) that the "Same-day Flexi-trip Arrangement" ("Flexi-trip") will be implemented for passengers travelling between WEK and Futian Station. Starting from 14 August 2023 (Monday), passengers travelling between the two destinations can directly use "Flexi-trip" from 45 minutes before the original departure time to within one hour after the train's departure* to change to designated trains up to three times on the same day for free. Compared to the current HSR regulations whereby passengers can only arrange one-time alteration of tickets up to 45 minutes before the scheduled train departure for free, "Flexi-trip" provides additional convenience for passengers commuting to and from Futian to change tickets for an additional of three times, making travelling more flexible.

Under "Flexi-trip", passengers must choose among the 38 designated same-day train services originating or terminating at WEK and Futian Station. This does not include trains with Futian Station as the intermediate station. Passengers can use the 12306 website or mobile app, ticketing machines at the B1 ticketing concourse, the "Flexi-trip" self-service machines at the B3 departure concourse, or ticketing counters at WEK to complete the necessary procedures. For passengers departing from Futian Station, they can use the 12306 platform, ticketing machines, and counters in the station to complete the "Flexi-trip" procedures.

With a few simple steps to arrange train alteration, the system will automatically assign a seat of the same class or a "Non-reserved Seat" to the passenger. Train tickets changed under "Flexitrip" are non-refundable.

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To ensure passengers can change their train trips even when seats are fully booked, "Non-reserved Seat" will be introduced for the 38 designated train services under "Flexi-trip". These seats will only be available at the designated time right before the train's departure** for "Flexi-trip" users for alteration of trains. Passengers assigned with "Non-reserved Seat" may need to stand in the designated train car during the journey.

In accordance with the current HSR regulation, all passengers can arrange "General Ticket Alteration" *** once for free. Under the current procedure, passengers can arrange "General Ticket Alteration" through the 12306 platform, ticketing counter, or designated agents (for tickets purchased through agents), including changing the date, train trip and class of travel. Upon the launch of "Flexi-trip", passengers travelling between WEK and Futian Station can continue to enjoy the "General Ticket Alteration" to change ticket once for free. For those who have previously used the "General Ticket Alteration", they can directly use "Flexi-trip" on the day of travel to change tickets to designated trains for free up to three times before the cut-off time (i.e. within one hour after the train's departure).

"The High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section) is a cross-boundary train service connecting to the Mainland railway network, with its unique management and operation standard. The launch of 'Flexi-trip' is not only a testament to the hard work of our team, but also the result of the unwavering support and cooperation from the Mainland's railway authorities and relevant departments of the HKSAR government. As the integrated development of the Greater Bay Area continues, cross-boundary short-haul travel has become an integral part of our daily life. 'Flexi-trip' marks a good start for the continued collaboration with our Mainland counterparts to explore more passenger-centric services, strengthen interconnectivity among cities in the Greater Bay Area, and fully leverage the advantages of the one-hour living circle," said Ms Jeny Yeung, Hong Kong Transport Services Director of the MTR Corporation.

To help passengers familiarise with the "Flexi-trip", a series of promotional and educational materials, such as webpage, leaflet, videos, and information pack have been prepared and will be distributed through various channels. Relevant station signage and public announcements and a helpdesk will be arranged and set up in WEK. Additional manpower will also be deployed to assist passengers during the initial launch of the new arrangement.

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- * Passengers departing from WEK can directly use "Flexi-trip" for free ticket changes from 45 minutes prior to original train departure to within one hour after the train departs. For passengers departing from Futian, they can directly use "Flexi-trip" from 30 minutes prior to train departure to within one hour after the train departs.
- ** "Non-reserved Seat" is only provided to "Flexi-trip" users for ticket alteration. These tickets will be available 45 minutes before departure of the northbound "Flexi-trip" trains, and 30 minutes before departure of the south-bound "Flexi-trip" trains.
- *** "General Ticket Alteration" According to "The Rules for Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong High Speed Rail Cross-Boundary Passenger Transport", passengers are entitled to free ticket alteration once, including changing the date, train trip and Class of Travel. The cut-off time is 45 minutes before their train's scheduled departure from Hong Kong, and 30 minutes before the train's scheduled departure from the Mainland. Each ticket can be altered only once and is non-refundable upon alteration.





To facilitate "Flexi-trip", self-service machines will be set up at the departure concourse of Hong Kong West Kowloon Station (level B3) for passengers' convenience (opposite to Gate no. 11 and for those passengers who have completed immigration). The ticketing machines at B1 level will also add the function for changing train trips under "Flexi-trip" starting from 14 August 2023.

3. During the initial launch stage of the new arrangement, Hong Kong West Kowloon Station will set up helpdesk and deploy additional manpower to assist passengers.
