MTR Enhances Service During Long Weekend for Mid-Autumn Festival and National Day Holidays
Free Rides for Child Octopus and Free Travels on Light Rail and MTR Bus on National Day

MTR Corporation will enhance train service during the long weekend for the Mid-Autumn Festival and National Day holidays this year by adding close to 900 extra train trips from 29 September to 2 October 2023 and providing overnight service for Mid-Autumn Festival, facilitating the public to go out to enjoy the festivities.

The Corporation will also provide free rides¹ to children using Child Octopus while all trips on the Light Rail and MTR Bus will be free² on National Day (1 October), to encourage the public to celebrate the day with their families.

Enhanced and Overnight Train Services during Mid-Autumn Festival

The Mid-Autumn Festival (29 September) is a traditional festival celebrated by the public. All MTR rail lines (except the Airport Express and Disneyland Resort Line) will gradually enhance service with evening peak train frequencies starting from 3pm on that day. The Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Kwun Tong Line (between Tiu Keng Leng and Ho Man Tin stations) and Tseung Kwan O Line (between North Point and Tseung Kwan O stations) will run train trips at about 2-minute intervals after enhancement.

Meanwhile, for the night of Mid-Autumn Festival, all MTR rail lines (except the Airport Express, Disneyland Resort Line and journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line) and seven Light Rail routes will operate overnight. MTR Bus routes 506, K51 and K54 will extend their service time for the convenience of those out celebrating the full moon. (Please refer to Annex 1 for details.)

Enhanced Train Services during National Day Holidays

From 30 September to 2 October, seven MTR rail lines (Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Kwun Tong Line, South Island Line, Tung Chung Line, East Rail Line and Tuen Ma Line) will run more frequent train trips during different periods to facilitate the public to be out to celebrate the National Day and watch the fireworks display. <u>Free Rides for Child Octopus plus Free Travels on Light Rail and MTR Bus for All Passengers on National Day</u>

In celebration of the 74th Anniversary of the Founding of the People's Republic of China, the Corporation will provide free travels for kids on 1 October with children using Child Octopus enjoying free trips on the heavy rail. Meanwhile, Light Rail and MTR Bus running in the Northwest New Territories will be free for all passengers on that day and passengers do not need to tap their Octopus at Light Rail stops or when getting on MTR Bus.
