Dr Rex Auyeung Re-appointed as Chairman of MTR Corporation

The MTR Corporation welcomes the Government's announcement today (7 March 2024) to reappoint Dr Rex Auyeung as the Non-executive Chairman of the Corporation. The new term of Dr Auyeung will take effect from 1 July 2024 to 31 December 2025.

Dr Auyeung said he is honoured to be reappointed by the Government. "MTR is an important asset of Hong Kong. Apart from serving the daily lives and travelling needs of the public, it also contributes to future railway and community development as initiated by the Hong Kong government. I would like to thank the Board and all the colleagues in the Corporation for their support, and look forward to continuing to work with the team to serve and build Hong Kong."

Dr Auyeung was first appointed as a Non-executive Director of the MTR Corporation on 7 March 2019 and has served as Chairman since 1 July 2019.
