MTR Rewards Passengers with "Ride 10 Get 1 Free" Promotion and Discount for "Monthly Passes" and "City Saver" Newly Compiled Fare Charts to Take Effect on 30 June

MTR Corporation announced today (31 May 2024) that there will be special ticket promotions to thank passengers for their support, including a "Ride 10 Get 1 Free" promotion for four weeks in July and a special \$50 discount on "Monthly Passes" and "City Saver" for three consecutive months.

From 1 July to 28 July 2024, the Corporation will launch a "Ride 10 Get 1 Free" promotion to give free-ride rewards to passengers who take MTR frequently. MTR Mobile Registered Users can earn a free domestic ride for every 10 rides taken with the Adult Octopus linked to their respective MTR Mobile accounts on Heavy Rail (except Airport Express) from Monday to Sunday during the promotion period.¹ Each registered user of MTR Mobile can earn up to 4 free domestic rides during the promotional period.

Besides, frequent MTR travellers will enjoy a \$50 discount for every purchase of "Monthly Passes" from July to September 2024, and of "City Saver" from 30 June to 30 September 2024 (based on the new prices).

"MTR is deeply rooted in Hong Kong and has been going forward together with Hong Kong people for many years. In sincere appreciation of the continuous support from the passengers, the Corporation is going to offer various special fare promotions to reward frequent passengers. The Corporation has also consistently provided different on-going fare concessions to passengers, including children, students, the elderly, persons with disabilities, etc., with the aim of alleviating some of the travelling expenses for those in need within our society," said Ms Jeny Yeung, Managing Director - Hong Kong Transport Services of MTR Corporation.

In addition, the Corporation has finalised the actual changes to individual fares according to the earlier announced 2024/25 overall MTR fare adjustment rate (+3.09%) under the Fare Adjustment Mechanism. The new fare chart for this year will take effect on 30 June 2024 (Sunday) (See Annex 1 for fare examples). In accordance with the FAM, individual MTR, Light Rail and MTR Bus fares will be adjusted with the weighted average adjustment of all fares combined equaling the overall fare adjustment rate.

¹ Not applicable on Airport Express, journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line, East Rail Line First Class Premium, Light Rail, MTR Bus and MTR Feeder Bus. The free rides can be used until 2 January 2025.

At the same time, the Corporation will continue to offer different fare concessions and promotions, including "Fare Concession for the Elderly", "Fare Concession for Children", "Student Travel Scheme" and various interchange discounts, etc. These benefit passengers from all walks of life, such as the elderly, children, eligible students, persons with disabilities, etc., as well as passengers interchanging into connecting public transports. The respective on-going fare concessions amounted to approximately \$2.9 billion last year.

The Corporation will also continue to offer different frequent commuters' tickets, including "City Saver" and "Monthly Passes", etc. Details of the new selling price of these tickets can be seen in Annex 2.
