MTR Chief Executive Officer Appointment

The MTR Corporation announces today (8 October 2024) the re-appointment of Dr Jacob Kam as Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation upon completion of his current term on 31 March 2025. The new appointment is effective from 1 April to 31 December 2025. The Board of Directors is grateful to Dr Kam for taking on the extended term and will activate a worldwide search to identify the right candidate for the post.
