“Cat/Dog Carrying Trial Scheme” on Light Rail Makes Good Progress To Be Extended Until End of August to Further Consolidate Opinions

Since May of this year, MTR Corporation has been running a two-month “Cat/Dog Carrying Trial Scheme” on Light Rail, aimed at providing greater convenience for passengers wishing to travel with their cats and dogs during weekends and public holidays, as well as promoting inclusive mobility. The Corporation expresses gratitude to passengers for their support and cooperation. The public’s response to the scheme has been generally positive with smooth operations maintained, and it has received recognition from various sectors of the community. The Corporation is currently reviewing the scheme’s implementation, consolidating and analysing the feedback collected since its launch in May. To gather further insights and better understand the scheme’s implementation under different travel patterns, the scheme will be extended until the end of the summer holidays.

Starting today (23 June 2025), passengers may purchase the “Cat/Dog Carrying Pass” for July through the MTR Mobile app.

Following the launch of the trial scheme, the Corporation has been gathering opinions from passengers, cat and dog owners, and other stakeholders through various channels. Observers have also been arranged to ride on the Light Rail, and Light Rail staff have been stationed at key stops to assist passengers in need. Observations indicate that the vast majority of cat and dog owners have complied with the relevant rules, including traveling on Light Rail during designated time, at designated location and using designated method.
