MTR Announces the Appointment of New Chief Executive Officer

MTR Corporation is pleased to announce today (25 June 2025) that following a global search by the Board, Ms Jeny Yeung Mei-chun, is appointed as the new Chief Executive Officer (“CEO”) for a three-year term, with effect from 1 January 2026.

Ms Yeung is currently Managing Director – Hong Kong Transport Services of MTR Corporation. Since joining MTR in 1999, she has held a number of key positions, including Commercial Director from 2011 to 2021, and Hong Kong Transport Services Director in 2021. In 2023, Ms Yeung was appointed Managing Director – Hong Kong Transport Services. She has been instrumental in expanding the station retail and advertising businesses, enhancing customer experience and leading digital transformation and the adoption of innovation and technology to promote smart mobility and smart asset management. She is currently Non-Executive Chairman of Octopus Holdings Limited and two of its group companies, and formerly Chairman of Ngong Ping 360 Limited.

Before joining MTR, Ms Yeung held various marketing and business development positions in Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited and Citibank in Hong Kong.

“As the backbone of Hong Kong’s public transport system, MTR plays a crucial role in keeping the city moving. Under the leadership of the current CEO, Dr Jacob Kam, the Corporation has achieved significant milestones in advancing Hong Kong’s development and growing sustainably as a business. Dr Kam also led the Corporation in overcoming the difficult challenges of the pandemic and returning the business to normality. The Board is grateful for his remarkable contributions. I am pleased to announce that the Board has appointed Ms Yeung as the next Chief Executive Officer following a global selection process.
