New Independent Non-Executive Directors Join MTR Board

MTR Corporation is pleased to announce the appointment of Ms Mary Huen Wai-yi and Mr Michael Wong Yick-kam as Independent Non-Executive Directors (“INEDs”) of the MTR Board, effective from today (27 May 2026), following approval by shareholders at the Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) held today. In addition, the Board has appointed Ms Huen as a member of the Nominations Committee, and Mr Wong as a member of each of the Audit & Risk Committee and the Finance & Investment Committee of the Corporation with effect from the same day.

“I warmly welcome Ms Huen and Mr Wong to the MTR Board,” said Dr Jacob Kam, Chairman of MTR Corporation. “With Ms Huen’s extensive management and leadership experience in the banking and financial services sector, and Mr Wong’s deep expertise across the business sector, financial regulation and public service, I am confident that the two new INEDs will bring valuable insights to the Board and further contribute to the Corporation’s long-term development and sustainable growth.”

Ms Mary Huen Wai-yi is currently an Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer, Hong Kong and Greater China & North Asia, of Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited, with over 30 years of experience in business management and banking services. Ms Huen plays an active role in Hong Kong’s financial sector and currently holds key positions including rotating Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson of the Hong Kong Association of Banks, Vice President of the Council of the Hong Kong Institute of Bankers, and a member of the Hong Kong Monetary Authority’s Banking Advisory Committee, etc. She is also actively involved in public service, serving on various public bodies including the Hong Kong Trade Development Council Belt and Road & Greater Bay Area Committee, the Human Resources Planning Commission, and the Advisory Committee on Corruption of the Independent Commission Against Corruption.

Mr Michael Wong Yick-kam is currently a member of the Exchange Fund Advisory Committee of the Hong Kong Monetary Authority, the Land and Development Advisory Committee, the Estate Agents Authority, and a Non-Executive Director of the Securities and Futures Commission. Mr Wong has extensive experience across the business sector, financial regulation and public affairs. He previously served as an Executive Director of Sun Hung Kai Properties Group and subsequently as a Non-Executive Director and Group Principal Advisor. He has also held various public service roles, including Chairman of the Council of The Hong Kong Metropolitan University and Chairman of the Hong Kong Youth Hostels Association, and contributed to the revitalisation project of Mei Ho House in Shek Kip Mei.

In addition, Dr Carlson Tong has retired from the Board as an INED with effect from the conclusion of the AGM held today. Dr Tong has served on the MTR Board for four years and acted as the Chairman of the Nominations Committee and member of the Audit & Risk Committee. Dr Kam expressed his most sincere gratitude to Dr Tong for his dedication and valuable contributions to the Board and to the Corporation during his tenure.
