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MTR Arranges Half-fare “Thank You Day” on 24 October

MTR Corporation announced today (15 September 2026) that a “Thank You Day”¹ will be arranged on 24 October 2026 (Saturday) in accordance with the “Service Performance Rebate” arrangement under the Fare Adjustment Mechanism, offering half-fare rides² to passengers.

On 24 October, passengers can enjoy a half-fare discount for every trip on the MTR, Light Rail and MTR Bus running in the Northwest New Territories with their Octopus or JoyYou Card, or when they travel with QR code tickets in the heavy rail network. Half fares also apply to cross-boundary journeys to and from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line. Passengers can also enjoy half fares together with any interchange discount, Fare Saver discount, the 25% discount on connecting journeys with Monthly Pass, as well as the Government Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities (the “\$2 Scheme”).

The Corporation will deploy additional staff at MTR stations to assist passengers and closely monitor train and station operations to suitably adjust train service and manpower arrangements when necessary.

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¹ According to the MTR Fare Adjustment Mechanism, once the Service Performance Rebate funding pool reaches the pre-defined amount, the Corporation will arrange a “Thank You Day” on a specific Saturday or Sunday.

² Half fare is not applicable to First Class on the East Rail Line, Airport Express, MTR Feeder Bus, MTR rides paid with physical/electronic Single Journey Tickets or contactless credit card/debit card, and High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section).
