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MTR Enhances Train Service for Mid-Autumn Festival Holidays Extended Service Hours on Evening of Mid-Autumn Festival to Meet Passengers' Travel Needs

MTR Corporation will enhance the service of various railway lines during the Mid-Autumn Festival and the following weekend (25 – 27 September 2026). On Mid-Autumn Festival, service hours of local railway lines and the Light Rail will be extended by around one and a half hours, with the last trains for different lines departing after 1am or 2am to meet passengers' travel needs during the holidays.

Starting from 3pm on Mid-Autumn Festival (25 September 2026), train services on eight local railway lines will be gradually enhanced, with an early start for evening peak train frequencies. Trains will run at about every two minutes on these lines to meet the travel demand from members of the public who finish work earlier on that day. The East Rail Line, Island Line and Tuen Ma Line will also run more frequent train trips during designated evening periods on that day.

In addition, the service hours of local railway lines (excluding the Airport Express, Disneyland Resort Line and journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line) and the Light Rail will be extended on that night, with the last trains of different lines departing after 1am or 2am. The service hours of MTR Bus routes 506, K51 and K54A will also be extended for the convenience of passengers returning home after an evening out. During the following weekend (26 – 27 September 2026), both Lok Ma Chau- and Admiralty-bound train services on the East Rail Line will be enhanced during various morning and afternoon periods. This includes increasing the train frequency to and from Lok Ma Chau Station from every 10 minutes to approximately every 8 minutes during selected periods next Saturday. (Please refer to Annex 2 for details.)

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Meanwhile, following discussions with Chinese Mainland railway authorities, long-haul sleeper train service between Hong Kong West Kowloon Station and Beijingxi Station will be enhanced, while more short-haul trips between Hong Kong West Kowloon Station and Futian and Shenzhenbei stations will be operated for the High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section) from next Wednesday to Sunday (23 – 27 September 2026). Passengers can refer to the 12306 website and mobile app, or the High Speed Rail website and app, for detailed information.

MTR will closely monitor operations of all railway lines and suitably adjust service as necessary to maintain smooth operations. The Corporation will also enhance passenger information through station notices, passenger information displays, public announcements, MTR Mobile and the MTR website, etc. to assist passengers in planning their journeys ahead.
